NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State "B"
Well No. 3 in NE/4 NW/4 of Sec. 16, T. 21S, R. 36E,
N. M. P. M., Barice Oil Field Lee County,
on May 21, 1935 34 lb. casing was 13223 { cemented { in Anhydrite
formation at a depth of 1675' feet on May 21, 1935
400 sacks of El Toro Regular Oil Well cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton plug method with
pressure

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 1675' feet and left undisturbed for at least
12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: Gypsy, Continental and Prairie
are being notified by letter.
