FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Drilled to total depth of 3480'. Ran 7" OD casing to 3480' and cemented with 775 sacks in two stages using Halliburton process. Cemented with 500 sacks around shoe and excess cement circulated out above two-stage tool at 1390'. Waited 6 hours then cemented with 275 sacks through two-stage tool. Will let cement set 72 hours and on February 16, 1952, at approximately 10:30 a.m., will drill plug & test casing shut-off.
