DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After a 24 hour shut-in period a back pressure test was conducted using a dead weight pressure gage and a 2" critical flow prover. Wellhead prover pressures were used for all volume and pressure calculations. The shut-in tubing pressure was 1100 psi, and the resulting ABSOLUTE OPEN FLOW WAS 27,000 MCF PER 24 HOURS with a 40° slope back pressure curve as measured from the horizontal.
