DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After a 26 hour shut-in period the tubing pressure was 1087 psia as measured by a dead weight pressure gage. Based on a back pressure test conducted on 4/10/51, which indicated an absolute open flow of 21,200 MCF per 24 hours with a shut-in tubing pressure of 2115 psia and a 430 slope back pressure curve, the calculated ABSOLUTE OPEN FLOW IS 20,200 MCF PER 24 HOURS.
