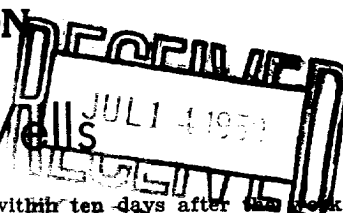

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A 2" critical flow prover and a dead weight gage were used to obtain the test data. The 24 hour shut-in pressure was 1102 psig, and the four rates of flow indicated an absolute open flow capacity of 21,200 MCF/day. The resulting back pressure curve had a 45° slope.
