
Gentlemen:

Re: Lockhart A-18 No. 1, Eumont Gas Pool,  
Unit P, Section 18-21-36, Lea County,  
New Mexico

Late in February, 1962, the subject well developed a casing leak in the 9-5/8" casing. To repair the leak, the casing was perforated at 3,000' with 4 JSPF and squeezed with 400 sacks. The cement circulated between the 7" producing casing and the 9-5/8" intermediate casing. Up until this time, the Lockhart A-18 No. 1 has been a bradenhead gas well producing from the Yates formation of the Eumont Gas Pool. Since the Yates interval has now been squeezed off, further gas production cannot be obtained from the well and the gas allowable should, therefore, be cancelled.

By copy of this letter we are also authorizing the El Paso Natural Gas Company to remove their sales meter and associated equipment, should they so desire.
