Pursuant to conversation with Joe LaMara (Carlsbad Office) on December 6, 1993, the following is offered as justification for continuation of temporarily abandoned status on EMSU # 415:

EMSU # 415 is currently a temporarily abandoned well in the immature, "pre-fillup," Eunice Monument South Unit. EMSU # 415 was temporarily abandoned, and the casing was successfully tested to 500 psig, on 10 - 22 - 89. The Eunice Monument South Unit has future plans for waterflood pattern realignments and possibly, a future CO2 project. It is requested that this wellbore be allowed to remain temporarily abandoned until its beneficial use is realized through one of the afore-mentioned future projects. During the duration of EMSU # 415's temporary abandoned status, casing integrity tests will be performed as prescribed by BLM requirements. It is requested, however, that the casing integrity tests be performed consistent with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission guidelines which allow for 5 years between tests.
