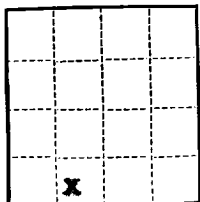

DETAILS OF WORK

Previous remedial work and offset information definitely establish the original open hole interval as being watered out. No recompletion possibilities exist and all recoverable oil reserves have been depleted.

1. Load hole with mud.
2. Spot 20 sack cement plug at 3700'.
3. Set 10 sack cement plug at surface and erect marker.
4. Clean and clear location.

All casing will be left in the hole.

A subsequent report will be filed upon completion of this work.
