EMSU #372 is an expired, formerly BLM approved temporarily abandoned well in the Eunice Monument Sout Unit, the following is offered as justification for continuation of temporarily abandoned status on EMSU # 372:

EMSU # 372 is currently a temporarily abandoned well in the immature, "pre-fillup," Eunice Monument South Unit. The wellbore was temporarily abandoned, using a cast iron bridge plug at 3800' (24' above the casing shoe), and the casing was successfully tested to 500 psig, on 3 - 8 - 90.

The Eunice Monument South Unit has future plans for waterflood pattern realignments and possibly, a future CO2 project. It is requested that this wellbore be allowed to remain temporarily abandoned until its beneficial use is realized through one of the afore-mentioned future projects. During the duration of EMSU # 372's temporary abandoned status, casing integrity tests will be performed as prescribed by BLM requirements.

Casing integrity and bradenhead tests will be performed during May 1995 and your office will be notified within 48 hours of said tests.

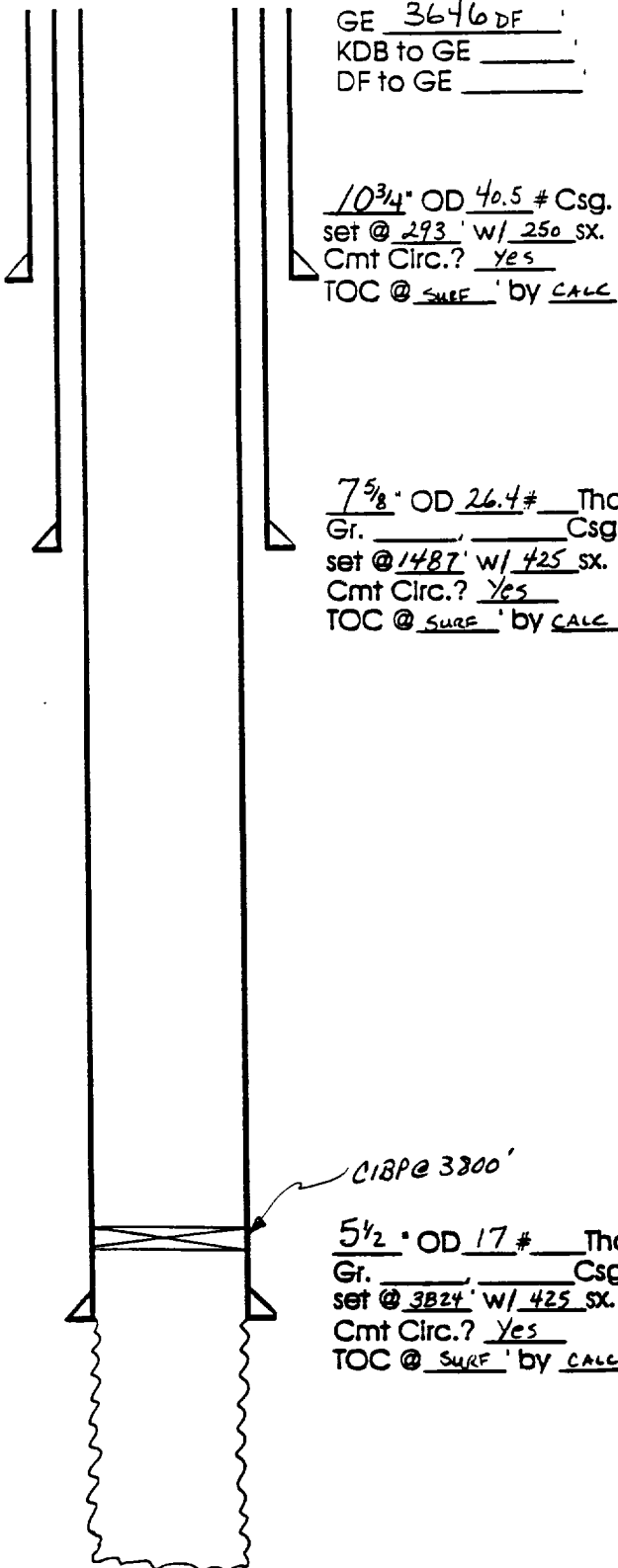

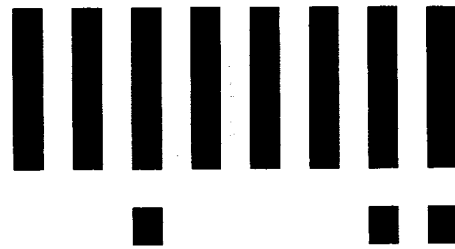

EMSU # 372 is currently a temporarily abandoned well in the immature, "pre-fillup," Eunice Monument South Unit. EMSU # 372 was temporarily abandoned, and the casing was successfully tested to 500 psig, on 3 - 8 - 90. The Eunice Monument South Unit has future plans for waterflood pattern realignments and possibly, a future CO2 project. It is requested that this wellbore be allowed to remain temporarily abandoned until its beneficial use is realized through one of the afore-mentioned future projects. During the duration of EMSU # 372's temporary abandoned status, casing integrity tests will be performed as prescribed by BLM requirements. It is requested, however, that the casing integrity tests be performed consistent with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission guidelines which allow for 5 years between tests.
