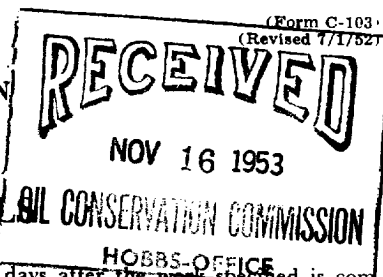

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

State "C" No. 1 well was dolofraced with 5000 gallon with 1# graded sand per gallon with packer set at 3713. Maximum injection pressure was 2400# broke to 1552# at the finish at 6.2 barrels per minute rate. The well was shut in for 21 hours prior to swabbing. The well was swabbed but only 43 barrel of fluid was recovered. Total fluid injected into the well was 180 barrel of oil and 120 barrel of dolofrac. The tubing load was 34 barrel. Since the treatment was unsuccessful, a C-102 is being submitted to temporary abandon this well as of November 13, 1953. No oil has been produced from this well during the month of November, 1953.
