Dear Pete:

According to the records in Santa Fe, there seems to be something irregular in the location of the wells of the Empire Gas and Fuel Company in Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 36 E., Eunice Field.

We have in our files Form SG 101 for the Empire State Well No. C-1 in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16-21s-36e, which shows this well to be located in the center of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the section. In other words a 10-acre location.

The records show that this well was begun May 10th, 1935 and that it was put on production July 22nd, 1935. You of course have a copy of this form in your files.

We also have form SG 101 for the Empire State C well, No. 3 in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the same section, date of November 6th, 1935, which shows this well to be located in the center of the quarter. On the basis of these records, the Empire now has two wells on the 40 which is not in accordance with the regulations of the Commission, unless there are some especial features involved.

Will you kindly investigate this matter and advise me of the true situation at your early convenience.
