Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool of Order No. R-520 for a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit for its Meyer A-17 No. 4 well located 1980 feet from South and West lines of Section 17, T21S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico.

This unit is proposed to consist of the Southwest Quarter and the South Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 17, T21S, R36E.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5 (b) in all respects as follows:

1. Said unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections (and/or lots).
2. Said unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
3. The entire proposed unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
5. Copies of this application have been furnished this date by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well, as required by the provisions of said rule 5 (b).

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the well and the offset ownership.
