NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TEST WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in triplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in O. L. Coleman
Well No. 2 in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, T. 21-S, R. 36E
N. M. P. M., Eunice Oil Field Lea County,
on Sept 24 1935. 7" in. 24 lb. casing was cemented in Limestone
formation at a depth of 3971 feet on Sept 21 1935
200 sacks of El Toro cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton Process

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of Dry feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.


