NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in O. L. Coleman  
Well No. 1 in NE/4 of Sec. 17, T. 21S, R. 36E,  
N. M. P. M., Marico Oil Field Len County,  
on October 4, 1934 34 lb. casing was 1200 cemented in Anhydrite  
formation at a depth of 1624 feet on September 30, 1934  
400 sacks of El Toro Regular Oil Well Cement cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company plug used with pressure.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 1624 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: Continental and Atlantic are now being notified by a copy of this form.

Additional information: Cemented 9-5/8" casing to bottom of cellar.
