## NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

on Aug. 9, 1930 19 7" OD 24 1/2" casing was { ~~XXXXX~~ } in Line  
formation at a depth of 3461' feet on Aug. 4, 1930. 19  
200 sacks of El Toro Oil Well cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton Process

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 2500' feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
