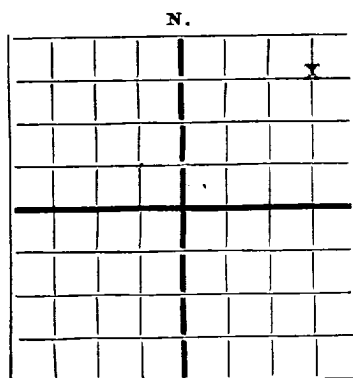

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector and approval obtained before drilling begins. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in triplicate. One copy will be returned following approval.

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 3450 feet.

Additional information:

10 1/2" casing to be set thru water sand and cemented to top  
8 1/2" to be set thru salt and sufficient cement used to protect salt  
7" to be set thru gas above pay and sufficient cement used to completely shut off upper gas.
