A letter of application (copy attached) has been filed with the Oil Conservation Commission, Santa Fe, New Mexico for approval to dually complete the subject well.

Present production is obtained from the Queen formation of the Bunice-Monument Oil Pool thru perforations 3853-59, 3862-68, 3872-78, 3882-85, 3891-98 feet.

It was proposed to perforate opposite the Seven Rivers formation of the Jalco Gas Pool from 3330 to 3450 and from 3612 to 3672 feet. A Baker Model D production packer to be set at approximately 3810 feet with 2-inch tubing set in the packer. In this manner it was proposed to produce oil from Queen formation thru 2-inch tubing and gas from Seven Rivers formation thru casing-tubing annulus.
