I am writing you to gain permission to centralize more than five wells to one tank battery on the State # 176 lease, loc, ated in section 19, township 21 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, Eunice Pool.

Wells number 2,4,5 and 6 on this lease are now making water and is necessary to treat. I have a treating plant serving wells 4,5 and 6. The oil from well number 2 has begun to cut so bad it is going to be necessary to install another treating plant on this lease for this one well. To save the cost of approximately \$2,500.00 for another treating plant and the cost of operation the life of the well, it is my desire to connect the well number 2 into the battery with wells number 1,4,5,6 and 7. I, already, have a treating plant at this battery, also, 5-500 barrel tanks. I have a 6" line from well number 2 to battery serving wells 1,4,5,6 and 7 that could be converted into a flow line. The proposed line is lotted on the plat attached. Well number 3 on this lease is a gas well and used to flow wells number 2 and 6. This lease is drilled up init there will be no further addition of wells to the battery.
