Atlantic Richfield Company requests administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate a previously established nonstandard 275-acre Eumont gas proration unit to four wells, the State 176 No. 2, No. 3, No. 4, and No. 6. Currently, the unit, W/2 E/2, N/2 NW/4, and SE/4 NW/4 of Section 19, T-21S, R-36E, Lea County, New Mexico is classified as marginal with all acreage dedicated to the State 176 No. 3 and No. 6.

The non-standard 275-acre unit was approved by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-5323, Case Number 5801 on the 30th of November, 1976. The State 176 Nos. 2 and 4 are completed in the Eumont oil, which Atlantic Richfield plans to abandon and recomplete in the Eumont gas.
