Atlantic Richfield Company respectfully requests administrative approval to form a non-standard 275-acre Eumont gas proration unit consisting of the W/2 E/2, N/2 NW/4, and SE/4 NW/4 of Section 19, T-21S, R-36E, Lea County, New Mexico. Currently, the previously approved 240-acre non-standard unit, W/2 E/2, and E/2 NW/4 of Section 19, T-21S, R-36E, is classified as marginal with all acreage dedicated to the State 176 No. 3.

Also, Atlantic Richfield Company requests administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate the newly-formed non-standard 275-acre unit to the State 176 No. 3 and No. 6. The State 176 No. 6, currently shut-in, was completed in the Eumont oil, which Atlantic Richfield plans to abandon and recomplete in the Eumont gas.

Atlantic Richfield Company believes approval of this request will protect correlative rights, promote conservation, and encourage the efficient recovery of gas reserves. Attached are an acreage dedication plat, a map of the area, and a list of offset operators who are being notified by a copy of this application.
