**It is desired to take gas from Meredith No. 1 to Meredith No. 2 periodically for the purpose of "kicking off" well No. 2.**

REGULATIONS

It is the policy of the State of New Jersey to conserve its natural resources and to protect its citizens from the harmful effects of pollution. To this end, the Office of Conservation has established the following regulations:

1. The Office of Conservation shall have the authority to:

- a. issue permits for the discharge of pollutants into the State's waters;
- b. set standards for the quality of the State's waters;
- c. conduct research and monitoring of the State's waters;
- d. enforce the provisions of these regulations;
- e. take such other and necessary actions as may be required to carry out its duties.
