DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

1. Kill well with water and pull tubing and packers.
2. Bridge hole with crushed lime to 3870' and cap with 10' cement plug.
3. Cement off gas zone. Cement to be pumped in thru tubing under pressure and set 3 days.
4. Pull tubing and drill out cement to 3860'.
5. Bail fluid down and test well to determine if gas is shut off. If gas not shut off, recement or run 5-1/2" casing on cement bridge at 3860'.
6. Drill out bridge and test productive zones. If large volume of gas is present below 3860', but above main oil zone, either cement or case it off.
7. If zones below 3860' produce oil with only a nominal amount of gas, clean out, tube and return to production. Acid treatment may be necessary to thoroughly clean out lower part of hole.

DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

1. Kill well with water and pull tubing and packers.
2. Bridge hole with crushed lime to 2870' and cap with 10' cement plug.
3. Cement off gas zone. Cement to be pumped in thru tubing under pressure and set 3 days.
4. Pull tubing and drill out cement to 2880'.
5. Pull tubing and test well to determine if gas is shut off. It was not shut off, recement of 2-1/2" casing on cement bridge at 2880'.
6. Drill and bridge and test productive zone. It large volume of gas is present below 2880', but above main oil zone, either cement or case it off.
7. If zones below 2880' produce oil with only a nominal amount of gas, clean out, tube and return to production. Acid treatment may be necessary to thoroughly clean out lower part of hole.
