Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public, but such operations should be witnessed by an Oil and Gas Inspector if possible.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Replaced mud with water, applied 1350# hydraulic pressure. After standing 32 minutes, pressure was 1270#. Casing O.K. Drilled out plug, cleaned out to 3941', blew hole dry. After standing one hour, 4 barrels water and BS entered. Partially filled hole with oil, blew dry again; let stand 1 hour and no water recovered.

Filled hole with oil and applied 680# pressure. Pressure dropped to 500# in 13 minutes. Applied 820# pressure. Pressure declined to 560# in 11 minutes. Apparently very small amount of fluid lost into formation and/or thru connection. Shut-off O.K.
