NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in O. Meredith
Well No. 2 in SE/4SE/4 of Sec. 19, T. 21-S, R. 36-E,
N. M. P. M., Eunice Oil Field Lea County,
on August 24, 1935 5 1/4" 17 lb. casing was cemented in Line
formation at a depth of 3377 feet on August 21, 1935
300 sacks of El Toro Oil Well cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton pump and plug.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of _____ feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: Continental Oil Co., Hobbs;
Repollo Oil Co., Hobbs; Shell Petroleum Corp., Hobbs.

Additional information: 1200# hydraulic pressure will be applied to
5-3/4" casing before and after drilling plug. If pressure test
after drilling plug is doubtful, fluid will be removed from hole
to test shut-off.
