Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public, but such operations should be witnessed by an Oil and Gas Inspector if possible.

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well stood cemented three days and 6 hours. Replaced mud with water and applied 1015# hydraulic pressure in 8-5/8" casing. Stood 30 minutes at end of which time pressure was 990#. Casing O.K. Drilled out cement 1482-1487', cleaned out to 1492', applied 1010# hydraulic pressure to 8-5/8" casing. Stood 30 minutes at end of which time pressure was 880#. No circulation around 8-5/8" casing. Small leak of fluid around plug and blow out preventer. Shut off O.K.
