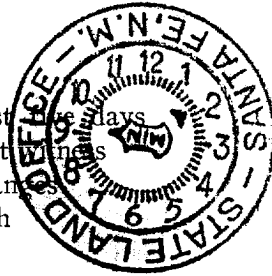

NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in The Calif. Co., Meredith
Well No. 2 in SE/4 of Sec. 19, T. 21-S, R. 36-E,
N. M. P. M., Eunice Oil Field Lea County,
on July 31 19 35 8-5/8"36 lb. casing was XXXX in anhydrite
formation at a depth of 1487 feet on July 23, 1935
700 sacks of El Toro Oil Well cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton; 2 plug.

Hydraulic pressure of 600# will be applied to 8-5/8" casing and allowed to stand 30 minutes before and after drilling plug.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of _____ feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
