DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On October 14, 1935, replaced drilling mud with water, applied 1310# hydraulic pressure, shut in and let stand one hour during which time pressure decreased to 1260#, casing O.K.

After making casing test, drilled out plug and cement from 3836 to 3853 and cleaned out to 3903' using oil for circulating fluid. On a one hour test after well had flowed 1 head, it produced 26 bbls. of oil and no water. Shut off O.K.
