Permission is requested to flow the eight wells on this lease into central storage. At the present time, wells #1, 2, 3, and 6 are flowing into the north battery, and wells #4, 5, 7, and 8 into the south battery. It is intended to salvage the north battery and consolidate production into the south battery consisting of 6 low 500 bbl. wood tanks. An individual separator will be left at each well. A manifold will be installed to permit testing of individual wells.
