NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in **State C-20**
Well No. **1** in **NW 1/4** of Sec. **20**, T. **21S**, R. **36E**,
N. M. P. M., **Junice** Oil Field **Lea** County,
on **6-26-34** 19 **13-3/8" 48#** lb. casing was **EXACT** cemented in **Redbeds**
formation at a depth of **307'** feet on **6-24-34 8 am.** 19
200 sacks of **Elter Cement, 50 Special** cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Pumped in by Halliburton Method, Pipe Cemented to top of Cellar.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of **307'** feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: **Getty Oil Co.**

Plug will be drilled to Bottom of Casing, & hole Bailed dry & Allowed to Stand for your inspection, or Witness by Adjacent property owners.
