NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State C-20

Well No. 1 in NW 1/4 of Sec. 20, T. 21S, R. 24E,

N. M. P. M., Eunice Oil Field Lea County,

on July 31st 1934 7" O.D. 24 lb. casing was { cemented } in Line

formation at a depth of 3849' feet on July 26 1934

400 sacks of Eltore cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Pumped down by Halliburton method. 12 lb mud circulated around bottom of 7" casing before starting cement in hole.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of _____ feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
