NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

on Aug 9th 1934 7" 24# lb. casing was { 1000# cemented } in Line

formation at a depth of 3820' feet on August 4th 1934

400 sacks of Eltoro cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Pumped in around casing by Halliburton method. 12 lb mud circulated ahead of cement.
