## NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State G-20  
Well No. 21 in NW1/4 of Sec. 20, T. 21S, R. 36E  
N. M. P. M., Run 100 Oil Field Lea County,  
on July 14th 1934 9-5/8" O.D. casing was ~~drilled~~ cemented in Anhydrite  
formation at a depth of 1449' feet on July 11th 8 Am 1934  
300 sacks of Eltore cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:

Pumped thru casing Halliburton method.
