NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in **State C-20**
Well No. **2** in **NW 1/4** of Sec. **20**, T. **21S**, R. **36E**,
N. M. P. M., **Sunrise** Oil Field **Lee** County,
on **7-4-34** 19 **13-3/8" 54.50#** lb. casing was **CEMENT** { in **Redbeds**
formation at a depth of **324'** feet on **San July 2** 19**34**
170 sacks of **Eltere** cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows:
Pumped down in casing by Halliburton Method.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of **326'** feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: **California Company.**

Plug will be drilled out to 326' and hole bailed dry and tested for water shut off.
