FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Authority is requested to produce seven wells, Nos 3,4,5,8,9,10 & 12, through a central treating plant into a centralized tank battery on Arnott-Ramsay "C" lease, Eunice Pool, beginning March 1, 1941. Well No. 10 recently started cutting, therefore it will now be necessary to treat its production. In order to eliminate a substantial expenditure to install a complete treating plant for this well, authority is asked to produce it through the central plant along with other wells. All wells on the lease are on the same basic property. There are no divisions of royalty. Separators and headers are so arranged that tests can be made as desired.
