Dear Sir:

Gulf and Tide Water Associated Oil Company have agreed to form a 640-acre Eumont gas pool proration unit, covering all of Section 21-21S-36E. The forms for the communitization agreement and the operating agreement have previously been agreed upon in connection with the Gulf-Tide Water Eumont gas pool proration unit covering the SE/4 of Section 8-20S-37E, which was approved by Order NSP-171, dated August 14, 1955. As soon as title papers are received from Tide Water, we will proceed with the preparation of the formal contracts to cover this unit.

In view of the above and the fact that the working interest owners are in agreement on the unit, we ask that the unit well, Gulf's Arnott-Ramsay "C" No. 13 in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 21 be put on production as soon as possible, with an allowable based on unit size of 640 acres in accordance with plats and forms C-104 and C-110, submitted with our letter dated December 28, 1955.
