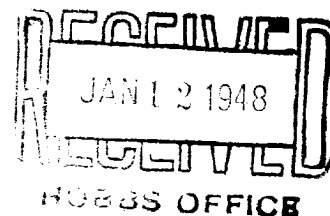

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The present total depth of this well is 3908'. In order to increase the production of this well and eliminate water production, we propose to spot 500 gallons of acid in the bottom of the hole in order to remove lime deposition from the well bore, run a Gamma-Ray Neutron Survey, plug back with plastic to approximately 3875', and acidize the formation with 3000 gallons of 20% acid. This well is now on pump and has 7" casing set at 3798'.
