Recent production tests indicate well is making approximately 13 barrels oil plus 70 barrels water per day. It is planned to plug back with plastic from total depth of 3880-3873 to shut off major portion of water and then acidize from 3816 (casing shoe) to 3873 with 2000 gallons to stimulate oil production. It is believed bottom 5' of hole is water zone and very permeable. Well will then be placed on the pump if unable to flow unassisted.
