DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

PBTD 3860' Ran 118 jts 3833' of 2-3/8" 4.70# tubing, set at 3836'. Perforations at 3832', 5 1/2" x 2' Type BOC Lane Wells H.W. Packer at 3697' w/5 Merla Type "W" flow valves: 375# at 3689', 400# at 3424', 425# at 2895', 450# at 2270', 475# at 1516', 137' of 1" pipe 3689' to 3826'

RESULTS: Initial flowed no oil 185 bbls water thru 2-3/8" tubing WO in 24 hrs ending 7-15-52. Formation gas volume 191,246 cu.ft. Formation GOR - no oil was produced. Formation GFR 1034/1. Input gas volume 182,745 cuft. Input GFR 988/1. Allowable None. Daily average production before workover 2 bbls oil 212 bbls water for April, 1952. Allowable before workover 3 bbls exempt.
