Re: Application of El Paso Natural Gas Company for Administrative approval of a 160 acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit in the Eumont Gas Pool for the El Paso Natural Gas Company Brownlee #1 Well which is located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company respectfully requests Administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of Order No. R-520 of a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit of 160.00 acres, more or less, comprising the SE/4 of Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

1. That as of April 18, 1956 the SE/4 of Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., was communitized in order to form a 160 acre unit for the Brownlee #1 Well.
2. That El Paso Natural Gas Company is the operator of said communitized tract.
3. That El Paso Natural Gas Company completed the El Paso Natural Gas Company Brownlee #1 Well in the SW/4 SE/4 of said Section 25, on January 6, 1957, with an Initial Potential of 49,500 MCF A.O.F. This well is located 760 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of said Section 25.
4. That the proposed Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5 (b) of Order No. R-520 in that the proposed unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections within a single governmental section, that the length or width thereof does not exceed 5280 feet, and that the entire area of the proposed unit lies within the horizontal limits of the Eumont Gas Pool and may
