Gulf Oil Corporation is the Operator of a 320 acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the E/2 of Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Arrow Gas Pool. The unit well is Gulf Oil Corporation's William A. Ramsay "1" Well No. 2 located 1020 feet from the north line and 460 feet from the west line of Section 25. An application for the approval of this non-standard gas proration unit was filed and in your Case No. 910, Order No. R-659, you approved the formation of the unit and provided for an allowable in the proportion that 320 acres bears to the acreage in a standard or orthodox gas proration unit in the Arrow Gas Pool.

Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner of the leasehold interest covering all of the E/2 of Section 25 by virtue of owning State of New Mexico Oil and Gas Leases Nos. A-735 and A-1543. Gulf is submitting its Application for Partial Consolidation of these leases to the Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico for his approval of such partial consolidation of the two above numbered State Oil and Gas Leases. The consolidation will be made for the production of gas from this unit within the limits of the Arrow Gas Pool.

Pursuant to the practice heretofore followed by the Commission, you are requested to place the unit well upon the gas proration schedule, effective immediately, allocating to it an allowable based upon the 320 acre unit in the Arrow Gas Pool.
