- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation proposes that the above-described acreage be established as a non-standard 320-acre gas proration unit in exception to Rule 5(a) of Order No. R-520.
- (3) The William A. Ramsay "B" Well No. 2, located 1980 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the west line, Section 25, T-21-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, was plugged back and recompleted on June 18, 1951, at a depth of 3729 feet as a gas well in the Arrow Gas Pool, and is producing from within the vertical limit of said gas pool as defined in New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-520. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (4) No other Arrow Gas well is completed on the 320-acre proration unit proposed under this application.
