

Administrative Order NSL-3000-B (SD)

Dear Mr. Godbold:

Reference is made to your application dated March 26, 1993 for an unorthodox Eumont gas well location in an existing standard 640-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Eumont Gas Pool comprising all of Section 27, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By Division Order No. R-4496, dated March 21, 1973, authorization was given to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas production to the subject GPU from the W.A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Well No. 17 located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the South and East lines (Unit J) of said Section 27 and the W.A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Well No. 46 located at an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit E) of said Section 27.

By Division Administrative Orders NSL-3000(SD) dated April 1, 1991 and NSL-3000-A(SD) dated July 24, 1991, two additional wells, the W.A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Well Nos. 35 and 42, located at unorthodox gas well locations in Units N and B respectively, were approved for the subject GPU.

It is our understanding that the subject well in this application was recently recompleted to the Eumont Gas Pool from the Lower Queen interval of the Eumont Oil Pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170 as amended, the following described well located at an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved:

W.A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Well No. 37 1980' FNL - 660' FEL (Unit H)
