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
It is our understanding that the subject well in this application is currently completed in the Lower Queen interval of the Eumont Oil Pool, however, said well will be plugged back to the gas producing Upper Queen interval of the Eumont Gas Pool upon issuance of this order.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well located at an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved:

**W.A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Well No. 29
610' FSL - 660' FEL (Unit P)**

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate Eumont Gas production from the W.A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Well No. 29 with the W.A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Well Nos. 17, 35, 37, 42 and 46. Furthermore, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from all six wells in any proportion.
