Gentlemen:

It is respectfully requested that the Oil Conservation Commission approve our application for a 160 acre non-standard gas proration unit embracing the S/2 NE/4, E/2 NW/4 Sec. 28-215-36E, and to be assigned to the Felton No. 1, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

The Felton No. 1 is located 660' from the north line, 1980' from the west line, Section 28-21S-36E, and produces from the Queen formation. After sandfracturing recently, this well produced 2,926 MCF gas per day.

An exception to Rule 5(a) Order R-520 is requested in order to assign the Felton No. 1 a 160 acre non-standard gas proration unit. This non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter/quarter sections within a single governmental section, and the entire area may reasonable be presumed to be productive of gas.

The attached plat indicates the acreage to be assigned to this well, and the offset ownership. All operators owning interests in Section 28, and within 1500' of the Felton No. 1, have been furnished copies of this request by registered mail.
