FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Felton No. 1 produces from the Grayburg (Permian) lime formation. Recently, this well was re-classified from the Eunice-Monument Pool to the Summit Pool. Under existing rules of the Summit Pool, any well having a gas-oil ratio in excess of 100,000 may obtain gas well status.

It is proposed to clean-out to total depth, run gamma ray and neutron log and sandfrac with 15,000 gallons refined crude and 15,000 pounds sand. Current oil production will probably not be increased. However an increase in gas production is anticipated. If less than 100,000 gas-oil ratio is secured, it is proposed to perforate and treat additional zones in order to secure a gas well allowable.
