Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of Order No. R-520 for an enlargement of the existing approved non-standard gas proration unit for its Lockhart B-28 No. 3 well located 1980 feet FSL and 660 feet FWL of Section 28, T. 21 S., R. 36 E., Lea County, New Mexico in the Eumont gas pool.

The unit is proposed to consist of  $2^{1}+0$  acres comprised of the SW/4 and W/2 of the NW/4 of Section 28, T. 21 S., R. 36 E.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5 (b) in all respects as follows:

- 1. Said unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- 2. Said unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 3. The entire proposed unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas,
- 4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
- 5. Copies of this application have been furnished by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well.

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge of belief the proposed unit, the location of the well and the offset ownership.

In view of the facts set out herein it is respectfully requested that the Commission issue an order approving the nonstandard gas proration unit for Continental Oil Company's Lockhart B-28 No. 3 well as described above. New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Page 2
