- (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas. 24
- (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
- (e) Gulf Oil Corporation is lessee and operator of all the acreage comprising the proposed unit as shown on the attached plat, and by copy of this letter of application, all operators owning interest in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operators within 1,500 feet of the proposed unit well are notified by registered mail of the intent of Gulf Oil Corporation to form the proposed non-standard gas prevention unit. (See attached affidavit.)
- (5) The approval of this application for a 160-acre non-standard gas prevention unit will, in the opinion of the applicant, prevent waste, protect correlative rights and serve the best interest of conservation.

In view of the existence of the facts herein stated and compliance with the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission's Order No. R-500, Gulf Oil Corporation requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described non-standard gas prevention unit.

(e) All acreage within the proposed unit shall be preserved productive of oil and gas.

(f) The length or width of the proposed unit shall not exceed 2,500 feet.

(g) Only oil conservation is leased and operated. All the acreage comprising the proposed unit as shown on the attached plat, and on any other plat of application, all operations shall be conducted in the section in which the proposed unit is located and all operations shall be conducted within the proposed unit and are notified by registered mail of the intent of O.C.C. Corporation to form the proposed non-extended unit. (See attached Exhibit.)

(h) The approval of this application for a unit shall be non-extended. Gas production unit will, in the opinion of the applicant, prevent waste, protect correlative rights and serve the best interest of conservation.

In view of the existence of the state-owned lands and oil companies with the provisions of Rule 5(b) of the Conservation Commission's Order No. 8-320, O.C.C. Corporation requests that the Secretary of the Commission approve the above described non-extended unit.
