DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was acidized with 3000 gallons of 15% acid on the above date after using a 5' jelly seal blanket. Zone acidized was from 3848'-7" to 3867.5'. This well was put on the pump and produced the following:

February 24, 1946 - 24-hour test - 26.0 bbls. oil - 230 bbls. water.
February 25, 1946 - 24-hour test - 25.5 bbls. oil - 225 bbls. water.
February 26, 1946 - 24-hour test - 25.0 bbls. oil - 160 bbls. water.
February 27, 1946 - 24-hour test - 42.0 bbls. oil - 230 bbls. water.
