NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State "O"
Well No. 1 in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 29, T. 21S, R. 36E,
N. M. P. M., Hunee Oil Field Lee County,
on December 25, 1934 1934 40 lb. casing was inserted cemented in Anhydrite
formation at a depth of 1805 feet on December 25, 1934
500 sacks of El Toro Regular Oil Well cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: Halliburton Oil Well Cementing
Company plug used with pressure.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 1805 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

Adjacent property owners have been notified as follows: Shell, Humble and Continental
are being notified by letter.

Additional information: Will drill plug and test water shut off on 12-29-34.
