NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in State "0"
Well No. 1 in NE/4 NW/4 of Sec. 29, T. 21S, R. 36E,
N. M. P. M., Sanico Oil Field Lea County,
on January 17, 1935 24 lb. casing was boxed cemented in Lime
formation at a depth of 3799 feet on January 17, 1935
480 sacks of El Toro Regular Oil Well cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: **Halliburton plug method with pressure. Stopped plug at 3759'.**

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of 3799 feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.
